INSTRUCTIONAL AIDE/PARAPROFESSIONAL TUTORIAL UPDATE

We are happy to announce that an updated version of the **CODESP Paraeducator/Instructional Aide Tutorial** has been posted to the CODESP website. It has been updated to match the most recent version of the Instructional Aide test materials.

If you are using older test materials for your Instructional Aide test, consider submitting a CATS Request Form to receive newer questions. You should periodically regenerate tests by opening <u>Create a Test</u> and selecting the <u>Packet</u> used for the test, then click on <u>Create</u> Test. This process will pick up edits to questions, but not newly developed ones.

The tutorial can be used in addition to the **Instructional Aide Test Practice Links**, posted under the **Links** section of the CODESP website - these links are accessible to all applicants and do not require user login. To access the Instructional Aide Test Practice Links, click on Links, then Test Practice & Study Materials-Various Sites, and scroll down to Instructional Aide. Various links in this area can be used as a resource, but are not affiliated with CODESP.

To access the CODESP Paraeducator/Instructional Aide Tutorial, log in to your CODESP account, click on Tutorials, then Instructional Aide Test Prep, then CODESP Instructional Aide Test Tutorial, and open the Instructional Aide Tutorial PDF. The tutorial is for member districts to share with their candidates only. CODESP user login is required to access it. Never share your login with others.

TEST MATERIAL UPDATES

CODESP staff continues to add and edit test questions and job families in both the **Multiple-Choice Item Banks** and **Interview Builder**.

Multiple-Choice Item Banks

We have recently added the following job families to our multiple-choice item bank and we've broken down the Transportation item bank to help meet your needs.

Remember that to receive the newest multiple-choice test items, you must submit a **CATS Request Form**. To receive edits only, regenerate your tests from your Test Library by clicking on the desired packet and walking through the test generation process by clicking on Create a Test. Let us know if you need assistance. Some subject areas require frequent updates. Do NOT use outdated test materials.
