We've all been there—needing to deal with conflict between co-workers, managers and employees, or directed at you, the HR professional. It would be great if we could just make it all go away but avoiding doesn't usually work. Instead, conflicts tend to persist and escalate, and managers and HR staff spend a lot of time and energy putting out fires. The good news: you can learn to manage conflict without losing your cool (or your mind!). In this webinar, learn some essential tips and tools for navigating conflict more effectively including:

- Understanding conflict and its sources.
- · Learning positive strategies for effective communication to resolve/avoid conflict.
- How to decide when to intervene and when to let people work it out themselves.
